

## CLEP Exams

The College-Level Examination Program® (CLEP) offers students the opportunity to receive college credit for what you already know. The 90-minute exams, which cost \$77 each, are administered at [1,700 test centers](#), and [2,900 colleges and universities](#). Visit <http://clep.collegeboard.org/started> for more information.

DCTC will not limit the total number of credits a student may earn through CLEP examinations. However, credits earned through CLEP are not resident credits and will not be used to satisfy resident credit requirements for graduation. Students must provide DCTC with an official report of CELP scores in order to receive credit.
